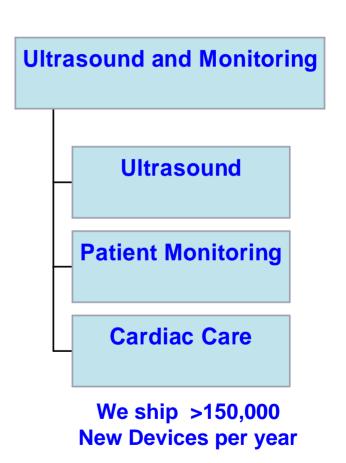

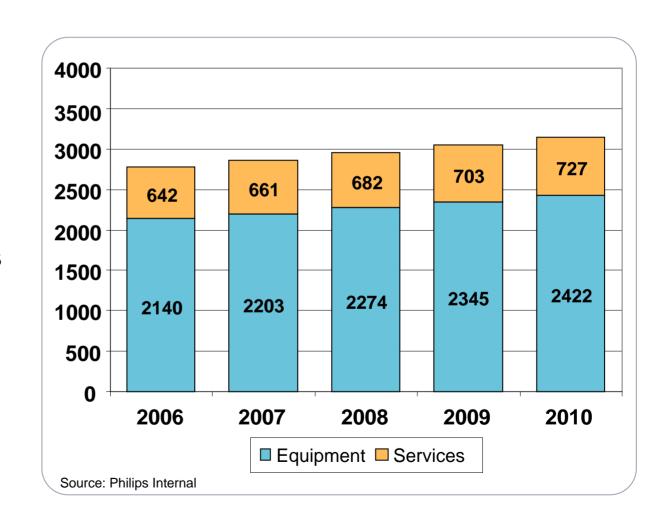
## Monitoring - Total Market Opportunity of €3.1B

Equipment Revenue + Service Revenue (€M projected)

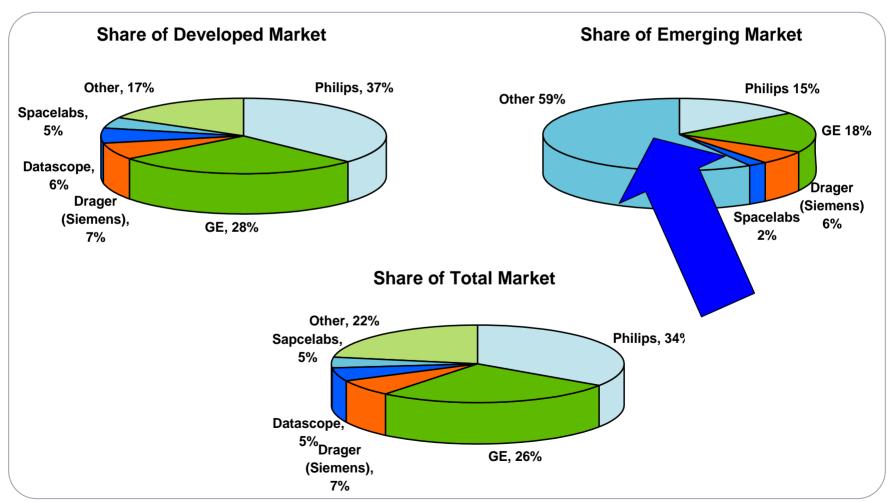

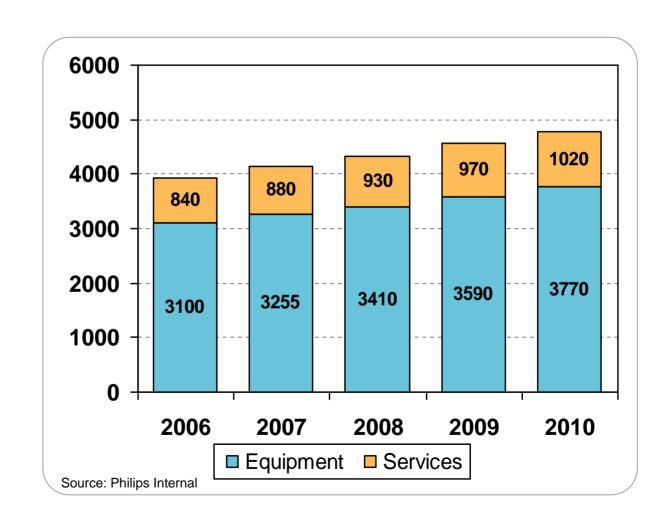

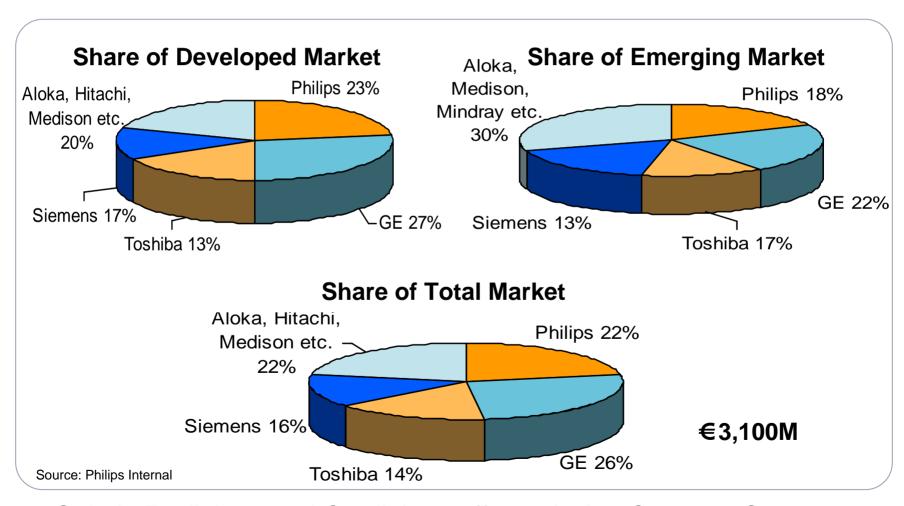

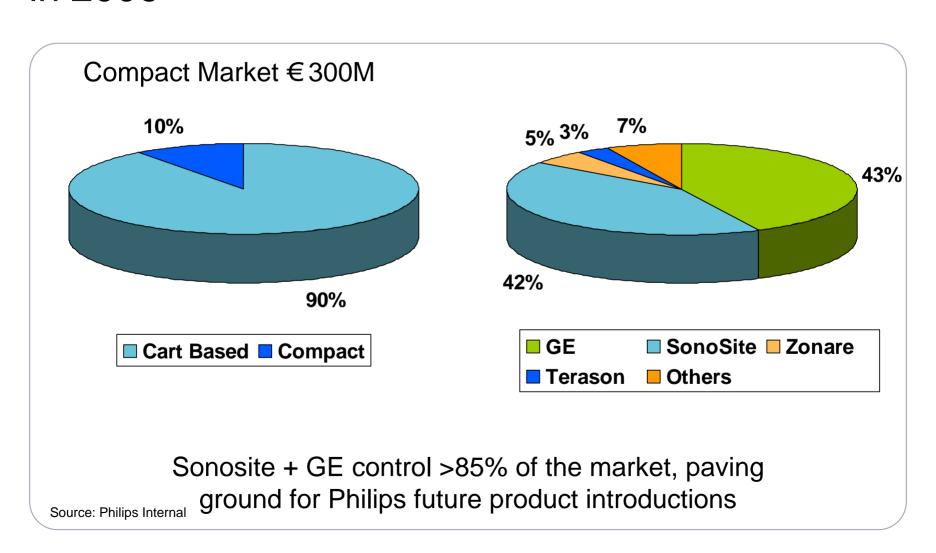


## Ultrasound – slight share increase in 2006

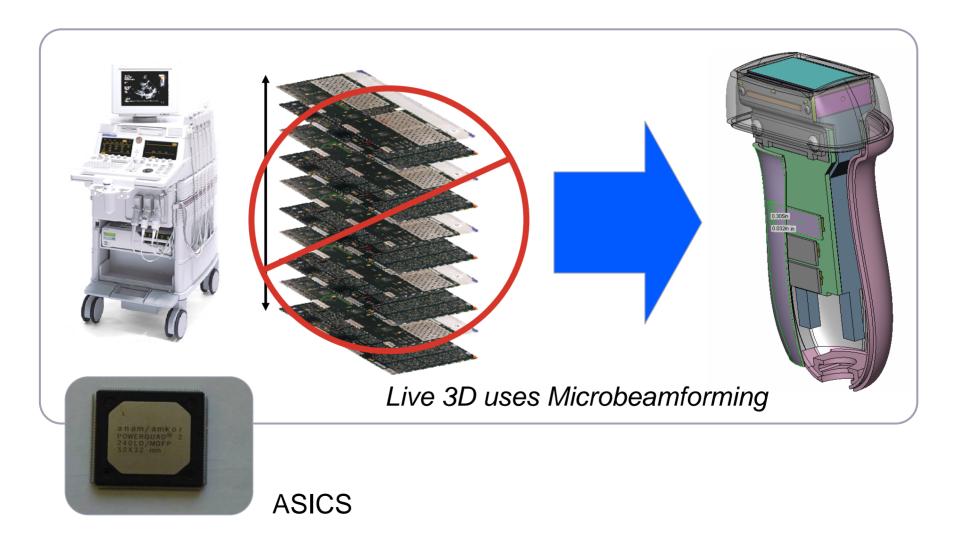


Gain in Radiology and Cardiology offset missing Compact Segment

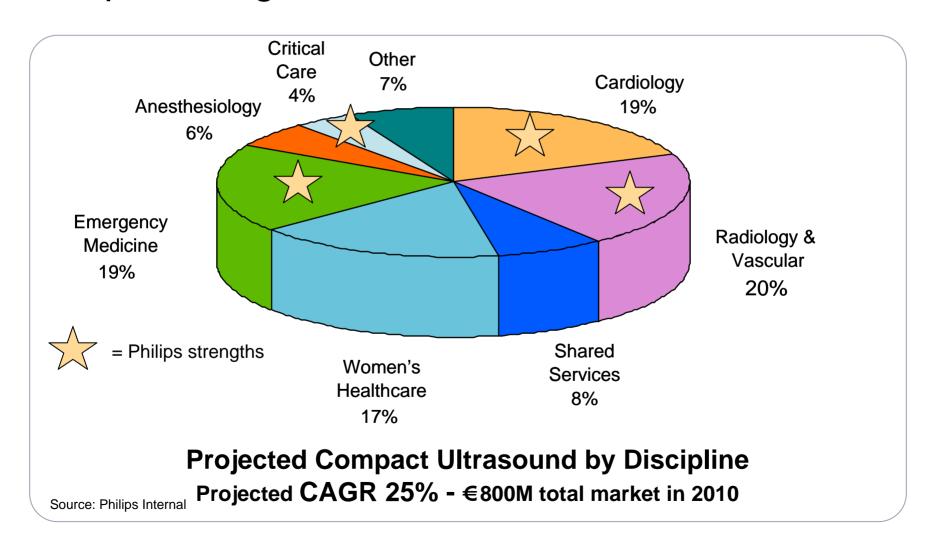
## Ultrasound - Compact Market grew to 10% in 2006

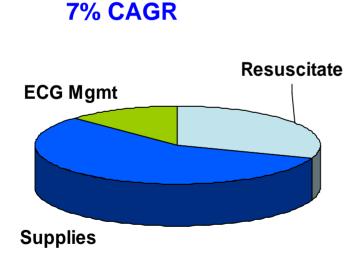


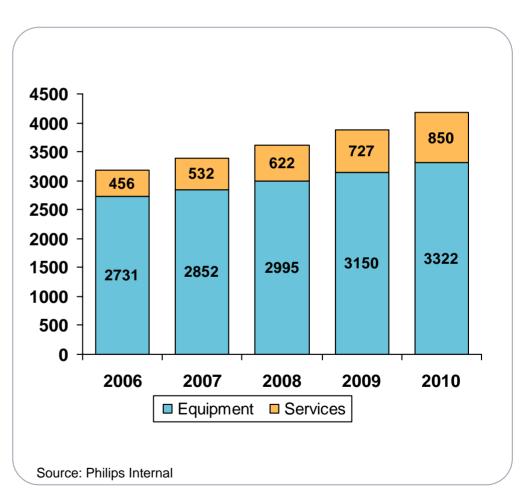

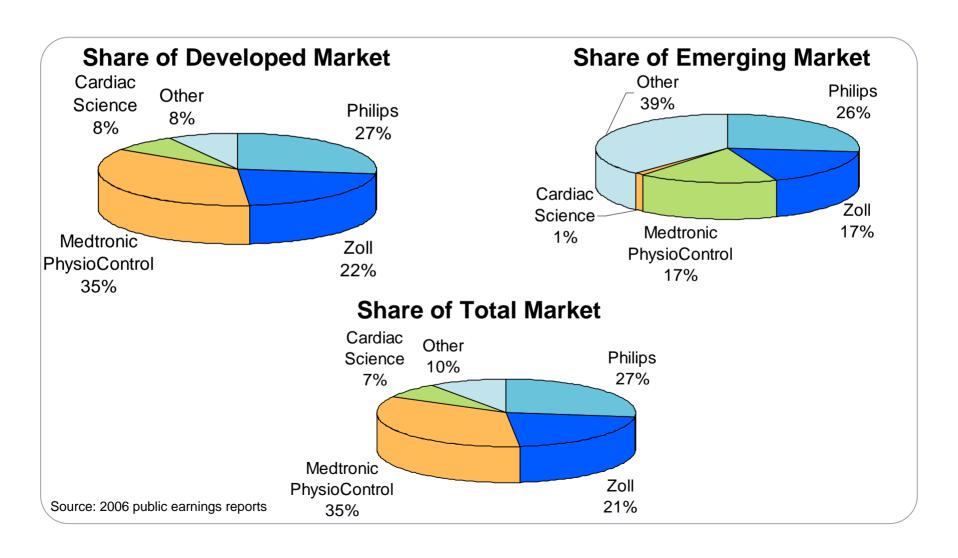

## Cardiac Resuscitation – Gaining Market Share

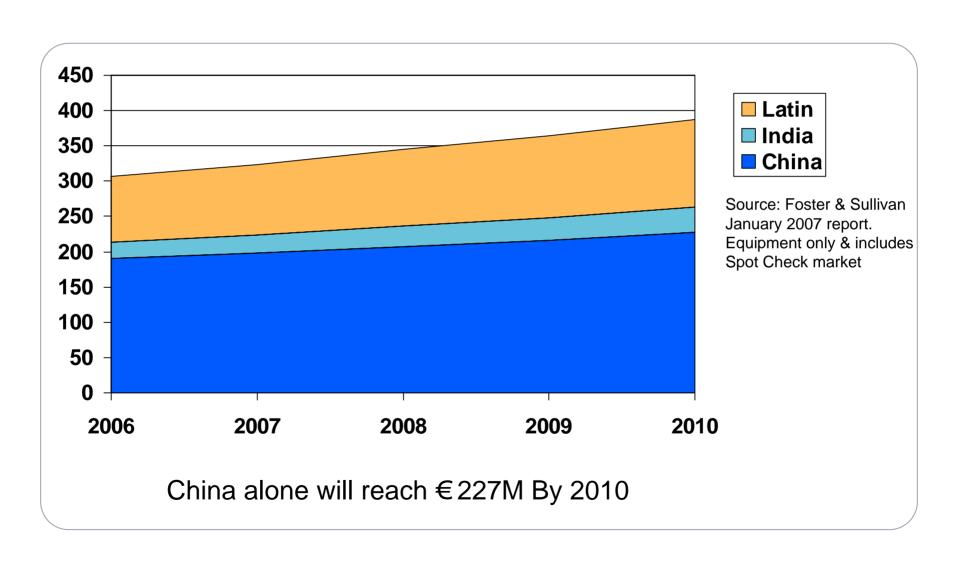

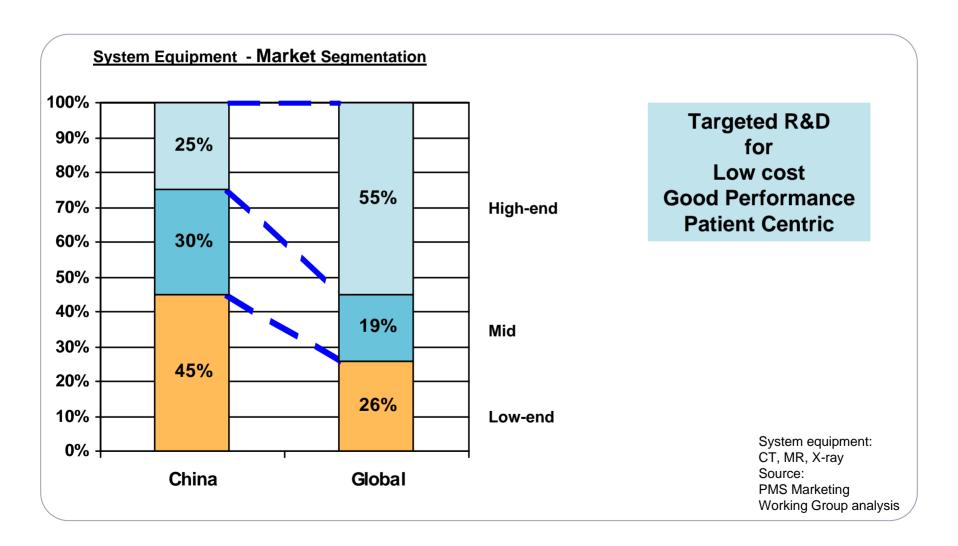
