LC Exam Preparation

The three-day LC Exam Preparation workshop takes place about seven weeks before the exam. It focuses on selected topics from the LC curriculum and provides techniques and practice for taking the exam itself. While the workshop does not address all of the LC material, participants will be able to review areas where their experience is weak, practice on multiple-choice and case study questions, and develop an action plan for their final preparation.

Who Should Attend

This workshop is intended for lighting practitioners (design, manufacturing, contracting, or sales) who have registered for the LC exam and have already begun a plan of study. Participants are urged to attend the Intermediate Lighting Systems and Technology and Lighting Application and Design workshops in advance of the LC Exam Preparation workshop. A Bachelor's degree and three years of lighting experience, or six years of lighting experience, are qualifications to be Lighting Certified.
