



Different type of Software packages



MultiOne updates.

Automatic – Check, download, install:	automatic check for updates, if available, download and install automatically automatic check for updates, if available, download them.
Automatic – Check, download only:	User has to agree to MultiOne update automatic check for updates, notify user, if new version available.
Automatic - Check only:	User can allow MultiOne to download and install the update.
Manual:	User has to force MultiOne to check, download and install any update.
