Introduction to **Luminaires**

The three-day Introduction to Luminaires workshop will be held in Fall River, MA. The workshop introduces the principles of optical performance, mechanical and electrical construction, and application for basic luminaires.

Workshop Content

- Principles of luminaire optics
- Reading a specification sheet
- Basic luminaire types and classes

For each of the basic outdoor luminaire types, we will cover what it does, where it is used, how it is constructed and how to specify and order.

Learning Objectives

At the completion of the Introduction to Luminaires Workshop, participants should be able to:

- Identify the construction, components, and function of key luminaires
- Communicate the performance attributes of key luminaires
- Apply these key luminaires to their common uses
- Use manufacturer literature and online information to identify products for typical applications
