But Nellie still felt like she could cry,

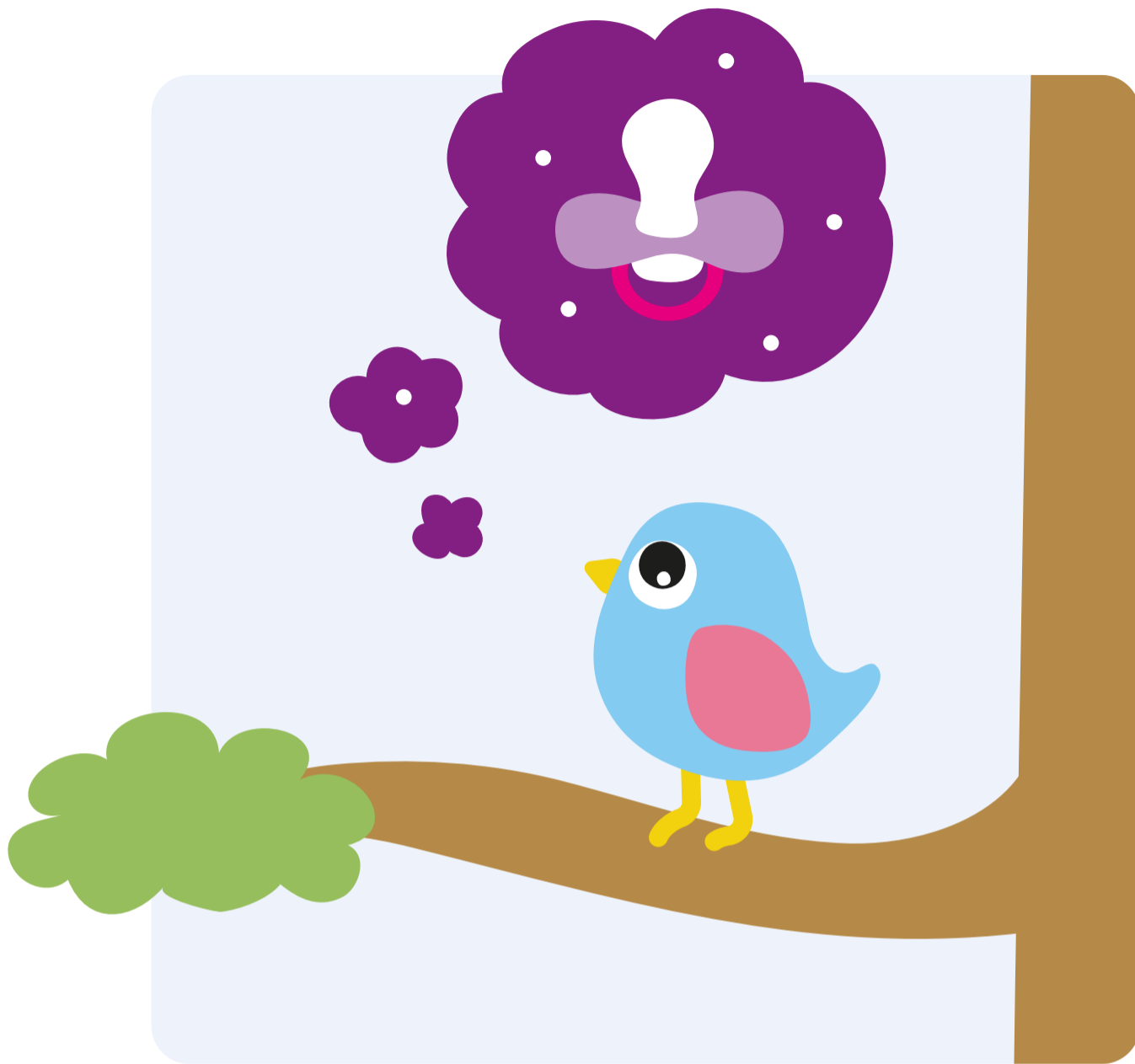
And had no answer when her friends asked 'why?'

A pacifier in their mouth, to let them soothe.

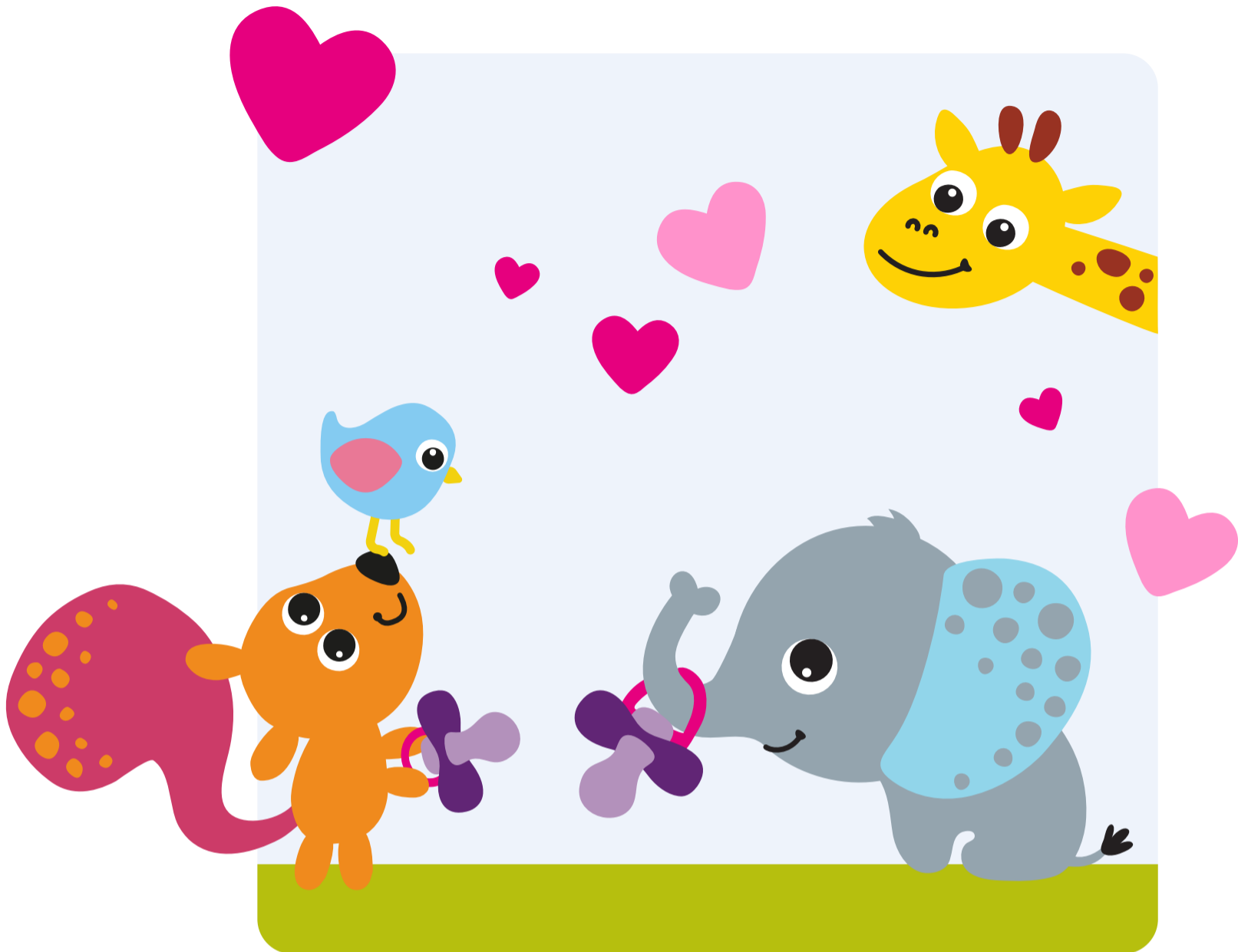


Perhaps one little human wants to help us too?
